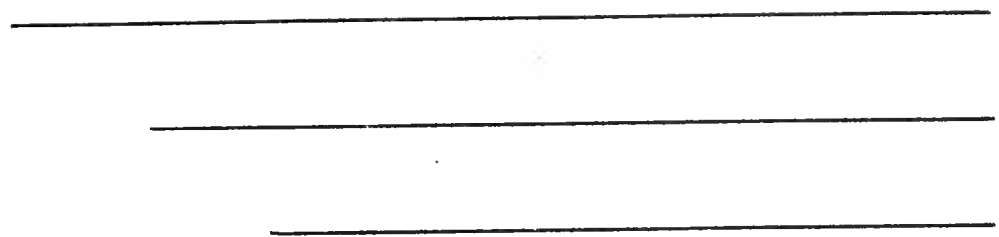

Sow one pound of seed to 400 square feet in starting a new lawn, and smaller quantities according to needs for old lawns.

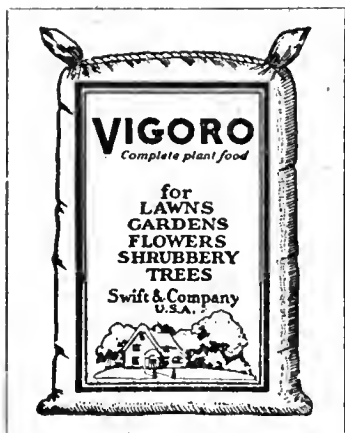
